Passing the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) has kicked America's clean energy sector into high gear, providing thousands of new clean energy jobs and reducing climate pollution across Arizona. Climate and clean energy investments in ten projects in Arizona's communities of color have already spurred \$8.25 billion in investment, and created or advanced 12,120 good-paying clean energy jobs.¹

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¹ For the purpose of this analysis, we define communities of color as counties, cities, or towns with "significant populations" of residents who are either Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Asian, or Native American. We define "significant populations" as those at or above the national average as per the 2020 U.S. Census – which stands at 13.6% or more Black/African American, 18.9% or more Hispanic/Latino, 6.1% or more Asian, 1.3% or more Native American, snd 0.3% or more Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander.

SPOTLIGHT: ARIZONA CLEAN ENERGY PROJECTS

Since the passage of the IRA, clean energy projects in Arizona have been able to move forward, creating jobs and investing in the state's clean energy economy:

- → All ten of Arizona's clean energy projects in communities of color have significant Native American populations. Nationwide, Arizona ranks 1st for the number of projects, 1st for investments and 1st for jobs in Native American communities.
- → All ten of Arizona's clean energy projects in communities of color have significant Hispanic/Latino populations. Nationwide, Arizona ranks 1st for the number of projects, 1st for investments and 1st for jobs in Hispanic/Latino communities.
- → Arizona's 7th and 9th Congressional Districts each have 3 projects in communities of color tying for 2nd as the districts with the highest number of projects in communities of color nationwide.
- → KORE Power is building a gigafactory in Buckeye, AZ that will provide 6,400 jobs. The company's CEO applauded the IRA's passage, saying it provides an "incredible lift" to the gigafactory's development, which hopes to claim the law's tax credits. Additionally, the company has said that it expects demand for their batteries to increase because of the IRA's passage. Buckeye's population is 46.6% Hispanic/Latino.
- → LG Energy Solutions (LGES) first announced a \$1.4 billion investment to build a Queen Creek, AZ, battery factory in March 2022 but was put on hold in June 2022. Following the IRA's passage, LGES announced it would invest \$5.6 billion in the previously paused Arizona gigafactory. An LGES Executive said the company was adjusting plans for the project to meet increasing demand driven by the IRA. Maricopa County, where Queen Creek is located, is 32% Hispanic/Latino.
- → In October 2022, Evelution Energy announced it would develop a battery-grade cobalt sulfate processing facility in Yuma County, Arizona, which is 0.3% Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander. The facility will create 360 jobs while providing 40% of the expected 2027 U.S. cobalt demand, which will be driven by EVs. Evelution Energy said it would provide free training programs for its new workers at the Arizona Western College campus.

- → In September 2022, Cirba Solutions announced it would build a new lithium-ion battery recycling facility in Eloy, AZ, citing new incentives from the IRA. The population of Pinal County, where Eloy is located, is 6.5% Native American.
- → After acquiring Sun Streams 3 from First Solar in February 2021, Longroad Energy completed financing for a Arlington, AZ, project in January 2023. Longroad's CEO said he believes the IRA will enable future developments and provide benefits to both utilities and ratepayers. Maricopa County, where Arlington is located, is 2.9% Native American.
